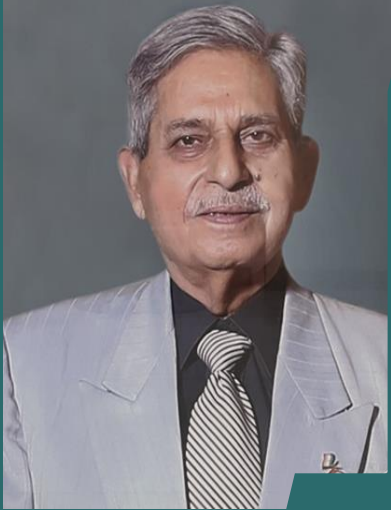

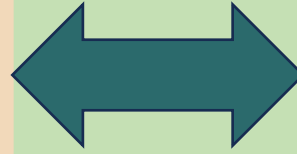

OUR DIFFERENTIATORS

Company Formation Program

In this program practical exposure is given to the students right from the formation to the winding up of the company. So far, eight companies Craft Crunch, Tangled Threads, Celebrino, Stamades, Old Bricks, Grow Graphical, Commerce Kitchen, and Fashion Fizz have been formed and have generated fruitful dividends.

Stipend-Based Internship

We are the only college in the region under Punjabi University, Patiala, that arranges stipend-based internships for BBA students during the course. The highest amount received by our student (Jan-May 2024) is was Rs. 15,000 p.m (for 6 months) and the average stipend amount is Rs. 7,000.

UGC-NET Coaching

The college imparts UGC-NET coaching to M.Com. students free of cost. This test is conducted to determine the eligibility of Assistant Professors and for the award of Junior Research Fellowships in Indian Universities and Colleges.

Online Trading in Stock Market

The college provides training for Online Trading. The students are made to learn stock market working and are also taught how to create and manage their own portfolios, apply concepts like bid, future, option & much more.

Self Defence Workshop for Girls

To equip the girl students with the requisite skills of self defence, the college conducts workshops for them in which they are trained under the able guidance of experts. So far, six workshops have been successfully completed where in more than 250 girls have been trained.

Workshop on Happiness for Students

At SD College, Kheri Gurna, we are not only concerned about the academic performance of the students but also about their overall well-being. For the first time, 6 Week Happiness Workshop was conducted for final-year students to ensure their emotional health.

Student-Mentor Relationship

IMPORTANT GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION

- The candidates are strictly advised to check the Admission Schedule and Eligibility Criteria for the desired course before filling up the admission form.
- A candidate who has appeared in the qualifying examination and his/her result is still awaited should submit the application form as per the admission schedule. However, he/she will be required to submit the result at the time of counselling.
- On the day of counselling, the candidates are advised to bring self-attested photocopies of all the original certificates, as mentioned in the box below.
- A candidate who has passed the previous examination from any Board other than Punjab School Education Board, Mohali/Board of School Education, Haryana/Himachal Pradesh Board of School Education/CBSE/ICSE Board, will have to obtain eligibility certificate from Punjabi University, Patiala.
- A candidate who has been placed under compartment/reappear in 10+2 examination will not be allowed to seek admission in any degree course in the college. If the candidate passes the compartment/reappear examination, he/she may be granted admission as per the admission schedule and the conditions laid down for this purpose by the Punjabi University, Patiala.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

All the candidates must produce the original documents/testimonials at the time of admission. They must submit/attach self-attested photocopies of each required document and the application form.

- 10+2 Examination Detailed Marks Card (DMC)
- Matriculation Certificate showing Date of Birth
- Character Certificate from the institution last attended
- If there is a gap in studies, an Affidavit about the activity undertaken during this period
- Migration Certificate from the previous Board/University other than Punjab School Education Board or Punjabi University, Patiala.
- A candidate who opts for Punjabi Elementary/Mudla Gyan will have to submit an Affidavit at the time of admission that :
 - he/she is not a resident of Punjab or,
 - he/she has not studied Punjabi at matric or +2 Level.



ADMISSION PROCESS FOR OLD STUDENTS

- Normal admission will be granted within 15 working days of declaration of University results or before the last date of admission, whichever is earlier or with late fee as per the rules of the Punjabi University, Patiala.
- The candidates are required to fill up the application form and attach a self attested copy of the result of the previous class.
- The candidates will also be required to show the original certificates to the admission committee, at the time of admission.

RE-ADMISSION RULES

- If a student after depositing the admission fee, remains absent for a stretch of ten days in the beginning of the session, his/her name would be struck off from the rolls of the college. The name(s) of such candidate(s) will be displayed on the Notice Board/Website of the college. The Principal may re-admit such candidate on receipt of request from the student, within one week from the date when his/her name was struck off from the rolls, justifying his/her absence from the class. But, in no case, the re-admission will be allowed after two weeks.
- If a student remains absent continuously for ten days during the course of study, his/her name would be struck off from the rolls. The name(s) of such candidate(s) will be displayed on the Notice Board/Website of the college. In case such a student does not seek re-admission from the Principal, within one week from the date of his/her name being struck off from the rolls, he/she will not be allowed re-admission.
- The name of the candidate will be struck off from the college rolls, if he/she fails to deposit the fee and all other dues within the stipulated time as determined by the college from time to time. The re-admission will be allowed within seven days with the permission of the Principal. The candidate will also have to pay the re-admission fee and the fine.
- If the name of a student is struck off for the third time, for whatsoever reason during one semester, his/her admission will be cancelled.

LEAVE RULES

- Leave up to maximum 8 days per semester will be granted on the condition of prior intimation.
- Leave only up to 3 days will be sanctioned by the respective Class In-Charge, and beyond that will be sanctioned by the Principal.
- Only those leave application forms will be considered that are duly signed by the Father/ Mother/legal Guardian of the concerned student.
- Leave up to maximum 10 days per semester will be granted on medical grounds, certified by an MBBS Doctor or a Doctor of a Government Hospital. The leave application must be submitted in the college office either during the leave period or immediately after the leave has been availed of.

CONDONING OF LECTURES

- If the required percentage of attendance is deficient on account of the participation of the student in Sports/NCC/NSS/Extra Curricular Activities, Educational Excursions, etc. approved by the Principal, credit may be given by the Principal for the number of day(s) for which prior sanction was obtained. This condoning would be over and above the limits provided in the existing rules and regulations.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR UNIVERSITY EXAMINATIONS

- The Examination form of the student will be sent to the University only based on the eligibility fixed by the Punjabi University, Patiala. The students are expected to consult the official website of the Punjabi University, Patiala (www.punjabiuniversity.ac.in) for any amendment(s) in these from time to time.

ATTENDANCE AND OTHER REQUIREMENTS

- According to the University rules to be eligible to appear in the University examinations, every student will have to satisfy the following requirements:
M.Com. B.Com. (Honours)/B.Com. /B.B.A. B.A. & DCA
- a) Every candidate will be required to attend a minimum of 75% lectures delivered to that class in each paper as well as 75% of the laboratory work, seminars etc. separately.
- b) Every candidate must have obtained in the MST at least 25% marks in each paper; 33% marks in the aggregate of all the subjects of the semester.
 - * Eligibility rules, attendance and other requirements are subject to change as notified by the Punjabi University, Patiala from time to time.
 - * The Principal at his discretion may allow a special test to a candidate who could not appear in the house examination owing to unavoidable reasons or fails to secure the minimum marks as prescribed above.

HOUSE EXAMINATION RULES

- House Examinations are conducted twice in a semester to determine the eligibility of the students to sit in the final university examinations.
- The following points are kept in mind while preparing the award list:-
 - A student who fails to appear in any paper in these examinations will be awarded zero in that paper, whatsoever be the reason for absence.
 - A fine of Rs. 100/- per paper will be imposed on any student who remains absent in these examinations without prior permission.
 - Any student who fails to fulfill the eligibility criterion in these examinations may be required to reappear in the Special Test on the scheduled dates as decided by the Principal, provided the Principal permits him/her to sit for the same.
 - A student found guilty of using unfair means in these examinations will be fined according to the gravity of the offence and will also be liable to detention or expulsion. It will also automatically render the student ineligible for the award of any prize, concession, scholarship or stipend for that session.

UNIVERSITY EXAMINATION FORM

- The University examination form must be filled up as notified by Punjabi University, Patiala.
- A student is required to fill up the examination form very carefully.
- For any mistake, the student will himself/herself be responsible & he/she shall be liable to pay the rectification fee/fine imposed by the University.

RESERVATION POLICY & FEE REFUND RULES

- The college will follow the Reservation Policy as per the rules of Punjab Govt./Punjabi University, Patiala and fee refund rules of University Grants Commission.

SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

GGDSD College, Kheri Gurna is committed to recognising and supporting students who have demonstrated a strong passion for education, enabling them to fulfil their aspirations. Our focus is to financially help the needy students who are brilliant in studies, and girls are given priority.

The scholarship shall be given to students with good academic records or to students who have shown excellence in other spheres of activities but fall under the economically backward section and belong to any of the following categories:

- Meritorious students
- Orphan/fatherless students
- Students with disabilities
- Sports (individual sport)
- War widows

Scholarship will be restricted to one semester only at a time. However, it will be reviewed based on the student's academic performance, conduct, attendance, and payment of college fee.

For meritorious students, scholarships will be given as per the following slabs:

- Students scoring 90% and above in 10+2 – Rs. 5000
- Students scoring between 85 -89 % in 10+2- Rs. 3000

The number of scholarships will depend upon the financial viability and resources available with the college.

The applications for the award of scholarships shall be called for by the end of October every year.

The students will have to provide necessary proof of income of their parents/occupation details etc. and any other information that may be called for by the college.

The Scholarship and Donation Cell shall scrutinise the applications received and will submit its recommendations to principal and chairman for approval by first week of November every year.

Such information will be duly authenticated by the local panchayat/municipal councillor.

The college has the right to cross cheque such information before making any final decision.

The students will continue to deposit their college fees as it is and the scholarship amount will be handed over by a cheque to the parents of the students with proper receipt.

Fees for wards of defence personnel will be according to the policies specially designed for them.

ANTI RAGGING RULES

RAGGING MEANS THE FOLLOWING :

- Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating, or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student.
- Indulging in rowdy or indisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student.
- Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student.
- Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher.
- Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic task assigned to an individual or a group of students.
- Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students.
- Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures causing bodily harm, or any other danger to health or person.
- Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, post, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student.
- Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student.
- Any act of physical or mental abuse including bullying and exclusion targeted at another student, fresher or otherwise on the grounds of colour, race, religion, caste, ethnicity, gender including transgender, sexual orientation, appearance, nationality, regional origins, linguistic identity, place of birth, place of residence, or economic background.

With or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.

RAGGING IS A COGNIZABLE OFFENCE

First Information Report (FIR) will be filed with police within 24 hours of receipt of complaint of ragging under the appropriate penal provisions relating to one or more of the following:

Abetment to ragging

Criminal conspiracy to rag

Unlawful assembly and rioting while ragging

Public nuisance created during ragging

Violation of decency and morals through ragging

Injury to body causing hurt or grievous hurt

Physical or psychological humiliation

Assault, as well as sexual offences or unnatural offences

Attempts to commit any or all of the above mentioned offences against the victims

Threat to commit any or all of the above mentioned offences against the victims

All other offences following from the definition of ragging.

Wrongful confinement
Wrongful restraint
Use of criminal force
Criminal trespass
Offences against property
Criminal intimidation
Extortion

PUNISHMENTS AT THE INSTITUTION LEVEL

Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges

Withholding /withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits

Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process

Withholding results

Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.

Suspension/expulsion from the hostel

Cancellation of Admission

Rustication from the institution for a period ranging from 1 to 4 semesters

Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period

Fine ranging between Rs. 25,000 and Rs. 1 lakh

Collective punishment : When the person (s) committing or abetting the crime of ragging is / are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment.

Prevention of Women Harassment Cell

This cell has been set up to speedily and effectively deal with any violation of sexual nature on the college campus. It provides an effective remedy to the aggrieved complainant at the earliest. Any student/employee of the college can lodge a complaint related to such violation with the chairperson of the cell immediately on or after the incident.

The Punjab Right to Service Act, 2011

The Punjab Right to Service Act, 2011 aims to provide for the delivery of services to the people of the state of Punjab, within the given time limits and for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto under this act:

Ø 'Right to Service' means a right to obtain the service within the given time limit.

Ø 'Service' means any service notified under Section 3.

CODE OF CONDUCT

The students of the college are required to observe the following Code of Conduct, both within and outside the College:

Ø Students must maintain discipline and decorum.

Ø Ragging is strictly banned in the college as well as in the hostel. A student found guilty of this crime may be punished heavily. It may also lead to his / her expulsion from the institution.

Ø Carrying lethal weapons like gun, revolver or other sharp-edged weapons is strictly prohibited in the College.

Ø Use of mobile phones in the classrooms and library is strictly prohibited.

Ø Smoking is strictly forbidden both inside and outside the college campus, hostel, canteen etc.

Ø Students are expected to conduct themselves with dignity, modesty and simplicity.

Ø Every student must bring his/her Identity/Library Smart Card daily and produce it, if any member of the staff or official of the College demands it at any time. Identity Card may be checked at the entry gate of the college and a student without it, will not be allowed to enter.

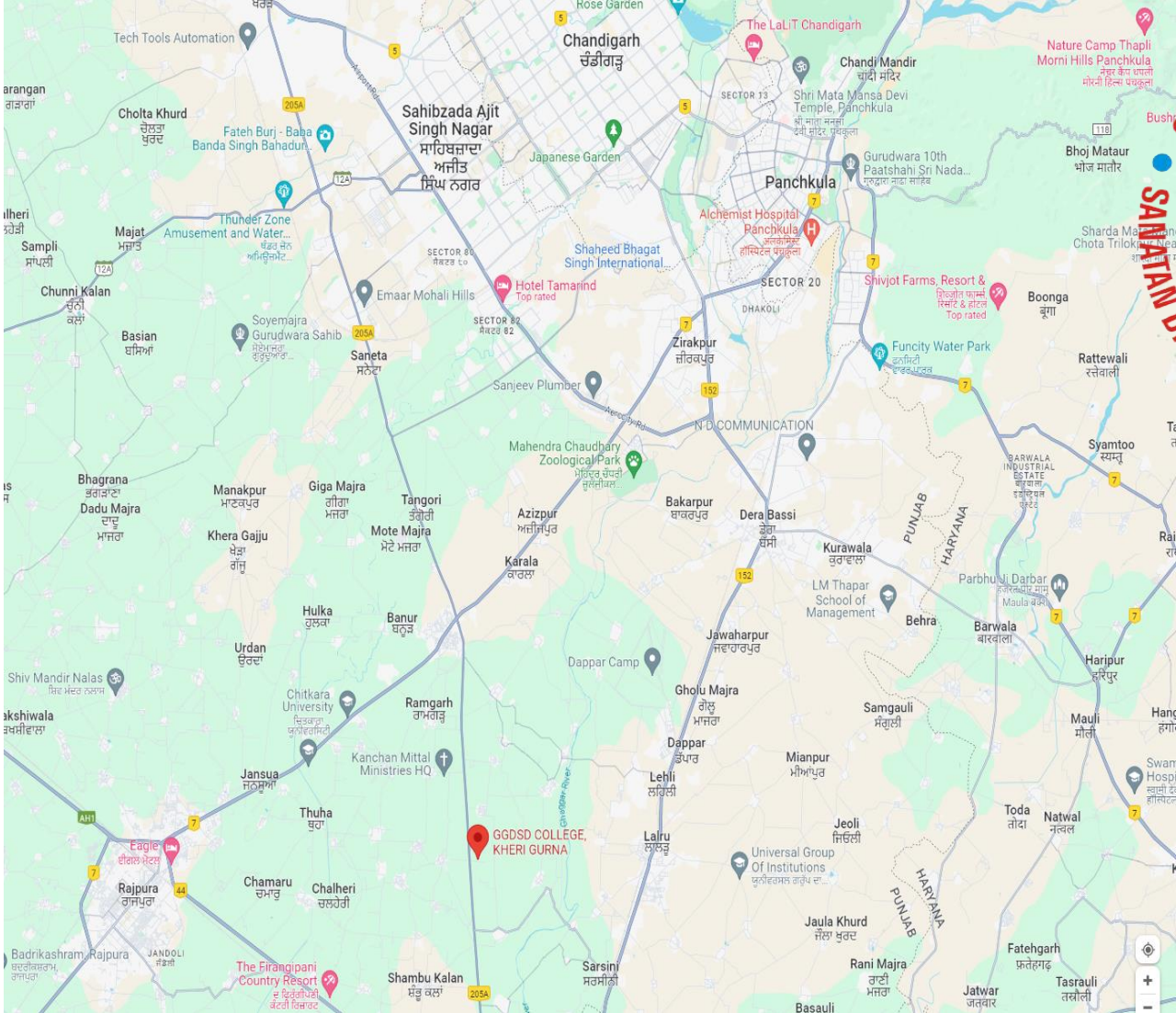
Ø Students must abide by all the rules, regulations and instructions issued by the College from time to time.
